Open to all students, grades K-12. Entries will be judged in three groups (grades): K-5, 6-9, 10-12.

Only one award will be given to an artist.

A maximum of two entries will be accepted and displayed.

Best in Show \$100.00

### Notification of Awards

Winning artists will be notified by mail and awards will be presented at the Young Artist Awards Ceremony held on Saturday, September 15 at 10:00am.

### Entry Eligibility

All entries must be the original work of the artist and not previously exhibited at the Quincy Artsfest. Artwork and photography must be framed, wired and ready to hang. **Clips, clamps or staples will not be accepted.** Sculpture or three-dimensional artwork must be accompanied by a safe, sturdy pedestal for display. The QAA reserves the right to reject any artwork deemed unsafe. Artwork or Photography larger than 22x28 must be accompanied by an easel for display.

**The QAA will not supply pedestals or easels.**

### Liability

The Quincy Artsfest will be held outdoors under tents and security will be provided overnight. All possible care will be taken to protect your artwork & photography. The Quincy Artsfest and its sponsors will not be held responsible for loss or damage to any piece of artwork or photography. Entry in this show constitutes your acceptance of all rules and regulations stated in this call for entries.

### Registration

1. Fill out the Registration form and send it with your Entry fee **before** the deadline of **August 13th** to the Quincy Art Association, 26 High School Ave. Quincy, MA 02169.
2. Tape the Identification Form to the back of your artwork or photograph.
3. You will receive a pick-up slip for each entry when you drop off your Artwork or Photography.
